Holy Confession and Holy Communion – Csemo Ucnosecm u Csemo Причешће: Please remember that Holy Confession will be heard Saturday evenings after Vespers or by a pre-arranged appointment at Church. During Great Lent confessions can also be heard after the Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts. With the exception of an emergency or other difficulty, confessions are discouraged before Divine Liturgy on Sunday morning because there usually is not enough time to hear a proper confession. Remember dear Sisters to wear a headscarf during Holy Confession and receiving Holy Communion. No confessions will be heard on Great and Holy Friday and Saturday.

House Blessing – **Boduua**: It is not too late to have your home blessed if it hasn't been blessed within the last year. There will be no house blessings during Holy Week. Please contact Fr. Ilija to make an appointment.

Pre-marital Counseling – *Пребраћни Савет*: Couples who wish to be married in our Holy Orthodox Church are requested to contact Fr. Ilija to arrange for pre-marital counseling sessions and setting the date for the wedding. Remember you don't have to have a civil marriage to have a valid marriage. A church marriage is just as valid in the eyes of civil authorities.

Lazarus Saturday – *Παзαρεδα Cyδοma*: On Lazarus Saturday Divine Liturgy will be served at 10 a.m. with a procession of willows (vrbe) around the church with the children. Parents please bring your children to church this day so they can participate in this traditional Serbian custom.

Sunday School – *Heдeльна Школа*: Our next program will be to commemorate Vidovdan. Please bring your children to Church regularly so that they can continue to learn about our Orthodox Christian Faith and Serbian Culture, and prepare for the Vidovdan program. If transportation is a problem please consider car-pooling. Last day of Religious Instruction this school year is June 4, 2006.

God-parenting - *Kymcmeo*: As all of you who are Godparents know, your responsibility to your Godchild is to help raise them in the Faith in which they were baptized. Sometimes parents are busy and cannot come to Church for honorable reasons. Why not take the opportunity during this Lenten Period to discuss with your kumovi how you can help bring your Godchildren to Church.

Circle of Serbian Sisters – *Koπo Cpncκux Cecmapa*: The Kolo Srpskih Sestara continues to grow and become more active in the Church. All Sisters are encouraged to be part of this very important Church ministry.
